<p>Admission Nurse: The Admission Nurse must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility, as defined by facility job description.</p>
<p>Definition of Care or Service: The Admission Nurse performs those functions necessary to support all aspects of the admissions process. These duties are performed in accordance with the facilities policies and procedures. Scope of service may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assessment of patient, development of a multidisciplinary age appropriate plan of care, initiation of physician orders, documentation of admission assessment and interventions. • Coordinates the services of the Nursing Admissions Department with physicians for the most comprehensive patient care. • Discusses information regarding patient with physician as indicated • Establishes and maintains communication process with all patient care; and for smooth operations of admitting, discharge and transfer. Gathers data relevant to the patient’s individual needs and age group • Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA Healthcare conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians.
