
Click the blank box in the **“Group”** column to view the entire section of documentation for that item.



Back on the Watchlist view, the leftmost column next to a patient’s name can be clicked to open the patient’s chart.




Also on the Watchlist, click the **Preferences** button in order to suppress other facilities, watchlists, or profiles. Users can also change the green checkmark icon to an indicator showing how long the patient has been on that profile.

Preferences must be set up by your EHR Analyst. If you are unable to click “Preferences”, contact the IT HelpDesk to request this access. No eSAF in required.



On the **Preferences** page, select the primary facility/job in the “Job Description” field.

Then change personal preferences to suppress certain facilities, watchlists, or profiles.



Users can change their “Default Management Mode” to “Watchlist” and select the Burn Watchlist as the default so that the Surveillance Desktop automatically opens to this watchlist.

With a watchlist selected, users may also choose to “Suppress” other watchlists/profiles that they do not wish to see.

Users may also **reorder** profiles on a watchlist with the blue up/down icons.

The default icon for patients who qualify is a green checkmark.

Users may find benefit in changing their preferences to show an Elapsed Time indicator instead. This allows them to sort by most recently qualified first.

Choose default facilities/locations as needed. Click **Save** to save the preferences.

Surveillance Profiles on the Burn Watchlist:

Burn Patients: Patients in house with Reg Service of "Burn Care", Complex Wound Type instance of "Burn", Consult to Burn and Wound order, or Lund and Browder TBSA documented. Patients will drop from this list if they no longer meet any of those criteria, or upon discharge.

Isolation Orders: Burn patients with an active Isolation order. Patients will drop from this list if order is discontinued or upon discharge.

Lund-Browder: Burn patients with Lund-Browder TBSA documentation completed by a provider. Patients will be removed from this profile upon discharge.

CM Consult: Burn patients with orders entered for Consult to Case Management or Consult to Case Management Specialty- with type of specialty response 'Burn'. Patients will be removed from this profile upon discharge.

SW Consult: Burn patients with orders entered for Consult to Social Services or Consult to Social Services Specialty- with type of specialty response 'Burn'. Patients will be removed from this profile upon discharge.

PT Consult: Burn patients with orders entered for Consult to Physical Therapy or Physical Therapy Evaluation and Treatment. Patients will drop from this list upon discharge.

OT Consult: Burn patients with orders entered for Consult to Occupational Therapy or Occupational Therapy Evaluation and Treatment. Patients will drop from this profile upon discharge.

Dietitian Consult: Burn patients in house with an order entered for at least one of the following:


- Consult to Dietitian, Adult
- Consult to Dietitian, Pediatric
- Consult to Nutrition
- Consult to Nutrition w/ Early Start Tube Feeding

Patients will be removed from this profile upon discharge.


NPO Order: Burn patients with an active NPO order. Patients will drop from this profile when order is discontinued or upon discharge.

'Burn Service Line Patients' More List option for Dietitians



A new More List option is available for Dietitians to view Burn Service Line Patients. This list can be found by navigating to **"Patient Care Status Board" > More Lists > Burn Service Line Patients**




This status board includes three additional columns with data points pertinent for Dietitians' review of the Burn patient population:

- TBSA
- MAP
- Avg REE (kcal/day)

Patients will be pulled onto this list by surveillance working in the background to identify patients admitted to the **Burn Service**, with **Consult to Burn and Wound** orders, **TBSA Lund**

Browder documentation, or **Complex Wound type 'Burn'**.

A **'Burn Patient' surveillance flag** is located on the board with lab results viewable in the associated data region.



Also viewable within the surveillance flag are details about the profile, as well as qualifying criteria outlining why this patient qualified for the 'Burn Patient' profile.
