




	Inactive order – this order has been discontinued
	Favourites folder
	Indicates that the order has an associated comment
	Reference Text- Indicates that reference information is associated to the order.
	Order waiting verification by pharmacist
	Order rejected by pharmacist
	Indicates an ambulatory order when orders are grouped by clinical category or order start date
	Order Details Not Complete - Indicates that there are required order details that have not been completed for the orderable. You can click on this icon and will be directed to the incomplete details
	Next missing required detail – switches to the next detail
	Dose Calculator - Launches the dose calculator.
	Taper dosing – Launch the taper dose window to increment/decrement the dose in a linear mode. Only works for inpatient orders
	High alert medication – Medication is associated with a high level of risk when prescribed for
	Physician Cosign- Indicates that physician cosign is required for the order
	Review schedule – the schedule for this order should be reviewed as doses may be too close
	Nurse Review- Indicates that a nurse has not reviewed the new order
	Non-LAM medication

Order Type Icons

	Documented home medication
	Ambulatory order – order for administration in an outpatient clinic
	Indicates an inpatient order when orders are grouped by clinical category or order start date
	Order from a discharge script
	Indicates that the order is part of a PowerPlan
	Care Sets- Indicates a care set orderable.

PowerPlan Icons

	Merge view – Show other orders for the patient in the order set window
	Initiate – initiate a PowerPlan
	View excluded components – Show the orders which haven't been ordered from the Powerplan
	Add to phase – select the icon to add an order to the current phase of the PowerPlan
	Indicates a note in a PowerPlan

MAR Icons

	Overdue task
	Order waiting verification by pharmacist
	Order rejected by pharmacist
	Priority/urgent task
	Order Details Not Complete - Indicates that there are required order details that have not been completed for the documentation.
	Additional charting elements – Click on the icon to complete eg. Pain score, BGL
	Task ready
	Interval warning – indicates the system was unable to evaluate the medication interval

	Collapse/Expand
	Flag – the charted result has been flagged
	Comment – icon in the top right corner of the cell indicates that the cell has comments attached. Hove over the cell to view the comments
	Modified - indicates that the charted result has been modified
	Insert date/time - click to insert a new column
	Customise view: use to customise the iview bands to individual preferences
