The layout of the Patient Care Status Board has been improved to more efficiently meet the needs of Infection Preventionists by bringing visibility to meaningful data elements.

The middle columns (2) house Surveillance Flags for the following Surveillance Profiles that are within the Infection Prevention Watchlist

- C. diff order pending on positive screening

Columns (3) contain Indicators that also serve as “launch points” into specified areas of the chart.

- **UNC** – this indicates that there are Uncollected Specimens on the

patient. When selected, this Indicator will launch into the Orders screen for the uncollected orders to be viewed.

- **Microbiology** – this indicates that there are Microbiology labs ordered/pending/resulted. When selected, this Indicator will launch the user into the Microbiology sub-tab of the Diagnostics tab.
- **Nsg/IP Notes** – this indicates that there are Nursing, Infection Prevention, or other Allied Health notes on the patient. When selected, this will launch the user into the Nursing/Allied Health tab of the Chart.

Special Indicators (4) now display as bold text.

The Detail region (5) of the Patient Care Status Board has also been redesigned.

Any applicable “Clinical Alerts” will display in the Clinical Alerts row of the second column (6). Currently, the two that may display are:

- TPN Orders
- Duplicate account – Do not use

As documented by nursing, the most recent documented Isolation status and Precautions will display in the first column (1).

All of column two (2) will display responses to the First Point of Contact screening.

- Pt/representative able to complete infection screening
- Pt/close contact traveled outside U.S. in last 3 weeks
- Have you ever had TB or a positive TB skin test
- Recent close contact w/person
