
## eMAR

## SDOH



### Understanding Social Determinants of Health (SDOH)

Nurses play a crucial role in patient care, which includes addressing the social determinants of health (SDOH). Having conversations with patients about SDOH can lead to better health outcomes and increased patient satisfaction.

As of January, hospitals are required to collect information related to Social Determinants of Health (SDOH) for inpatients patients 18 years and older. This will be collected using a new field in the Admission History form to inquire about instability or unmet needs in each of the five core domains.

### The Five SDOH Core Domains

Below are definitions for each domain to support conversations with patients:

SDOH Domain	Meaning
<b>Food Insecurity:</b>	limited or uncertain access to suitable quality and quantity of food at a household level
<b>Living Situation (Housing):</b>	inability to pay rent or mortgage, frequent changes in residence including temporary stays with friends and relatives, living in crowded conditions, and/or the lack of sheltered housing, not having a personal residence
<b>Utilities:</b>	inconsistent accessibility to utilities which include electricity, water, oil, and gas services
<b>Safety:</b>	partner violence, child abuse, and/or elder abuse
<b>Transportation:</b>	lack of access to transportation to get to destinations needed for aspects of daily living

## SDOH



### Addressing SDOH Core Domains with a patient

SDOH may be sensitive topic for some patients. To ensure individual choice and privacy, if patients do not wish to share information, nurses can indicate that the information cannot be obtained. Here are suggestions for sensitive SDOH discussions with patients:

#### Build Rapport:

- Create a comfortable environment for communication.
- Remind patients that answers to the questions will help provide the patient with supportive resources, including support from Case Managers.
- Demonstrate empathy and active listening to the answers provided.
- Sample introduction: "I am going to ask you about five socioeconomic needs. I am asking you these questions because these areas can significantly affect your health. By understanding if you have needs in these areas, we can provide you with supportive resources, including support from Case Managers. If you do not feel comfortable answering, just let me know."



#### Use Open-Ended Questions – Examples:

- **Food Insecurity:** "How difficult is it to have enough food in your household or money to get more?"
  - **Living Situation:** "Can you tell me about your living situation?"
  - **Utilities:** "How would you describe the consistency of your heat, electricity, and water services?"
  - **Safety:** "Do you feel physically or emotionally unsafe where you live?"
  - **Transportation:** "How do you manage transportation to medical appointments?"

### Vaccine Screening Assessment

The **Vaccine Screening Assessment** has been updated to be more compliant with CDC guidance and regulatory requirements, as well as provide shared clinical decision making. The updates include immunization administration dates collected by nursing and provider determination of eligibility and ordering of vaccines. The stand-alone COVID-19 Vaccine Screening Assessment has been retired, and the most recent administration date will be captured within this assessment.

**Note:** In order for the provider to determine vaccine eligibility, the **Vaccine Screening** must be completed as early as possible in the patient's encounter in order to meet HBIPS measures.

## Vaccine Screening Assessment

The **Vaccine Screening Assessment** has been updated to be more compliant with CDC guidance and regulatory requirements, as well as provide shared clinical decision making. The updates include immunization administration dates collected by nursing and provider determination of eligibility and ordering of vaccines. The stand-alone COVID-19 Vaccine Screening Assessment has been retired, and the most recent administration date will be captured within this assessment.
