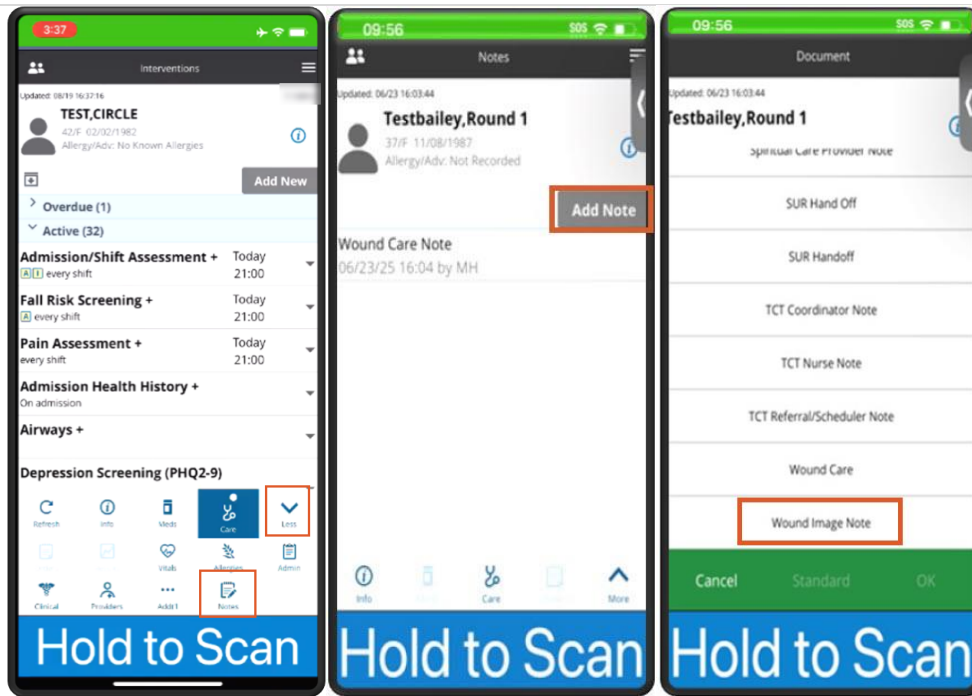


Expanse TIP SHEET

Wound Image Capture

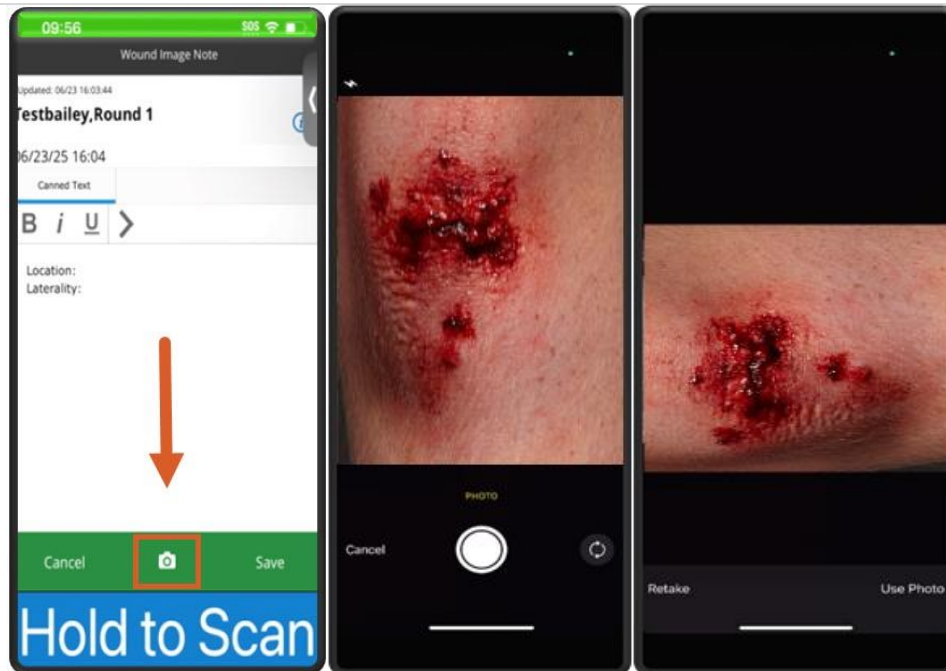


Expanse Mobile POC can add a wound image to a patient's chart.

After locating the patient in POC, use the More tab at the bottom to expand the menu and select the Note icon.

Select Add Note

Scroll down the list to find Wound Image Note.

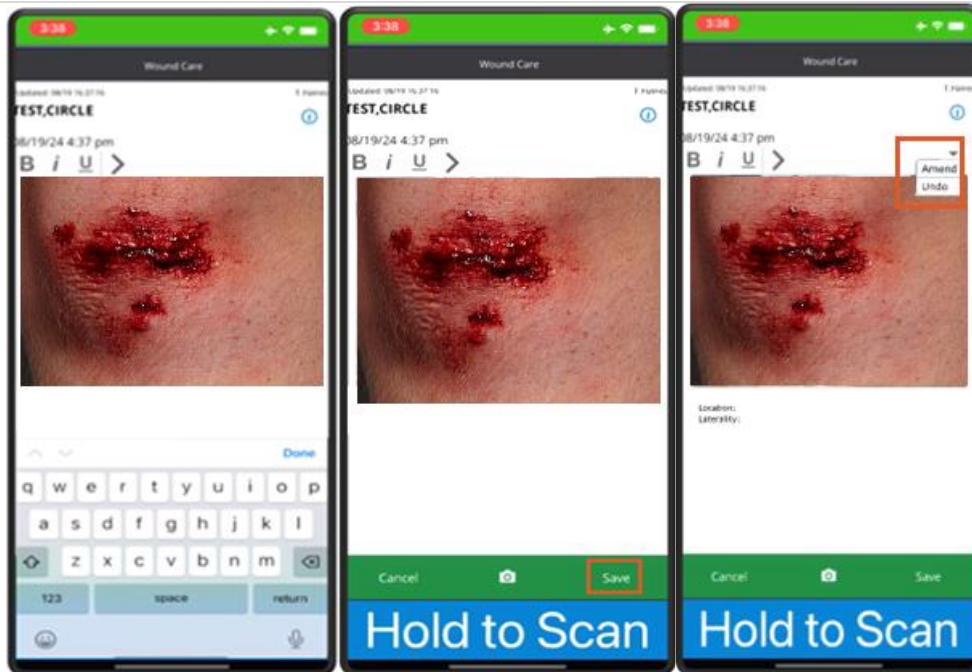


Add the Location and Laterality information.

Select the Camera icon.
Features:

- Turn camera for full length image. System will automatically adjust the view.
- Ability to retake photos.

****Follow your facilities wound capture protocol for camera distance and measurements. It is best practice to take the image 6in from the wound.**



Select in the white space under the picture to add verbiage about the image.

Multiple images can be added here by selecting the camera icon again.

Select Save when finished.

Use the drop-down arrow to edit after saving if needed. There will be a record of the edit.

***It does take several minutes for the image to load in the patient's chart.

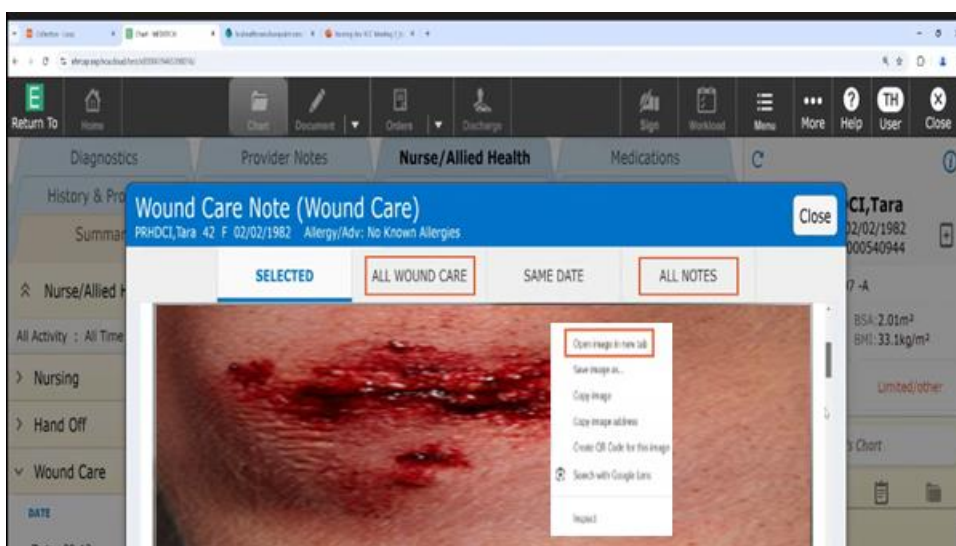

When viewing the patient's chart in Expanse Desktop, notice the Note icon containing the image.

***Always be sure to document all wound documentation within your wound assessment intervention(s).

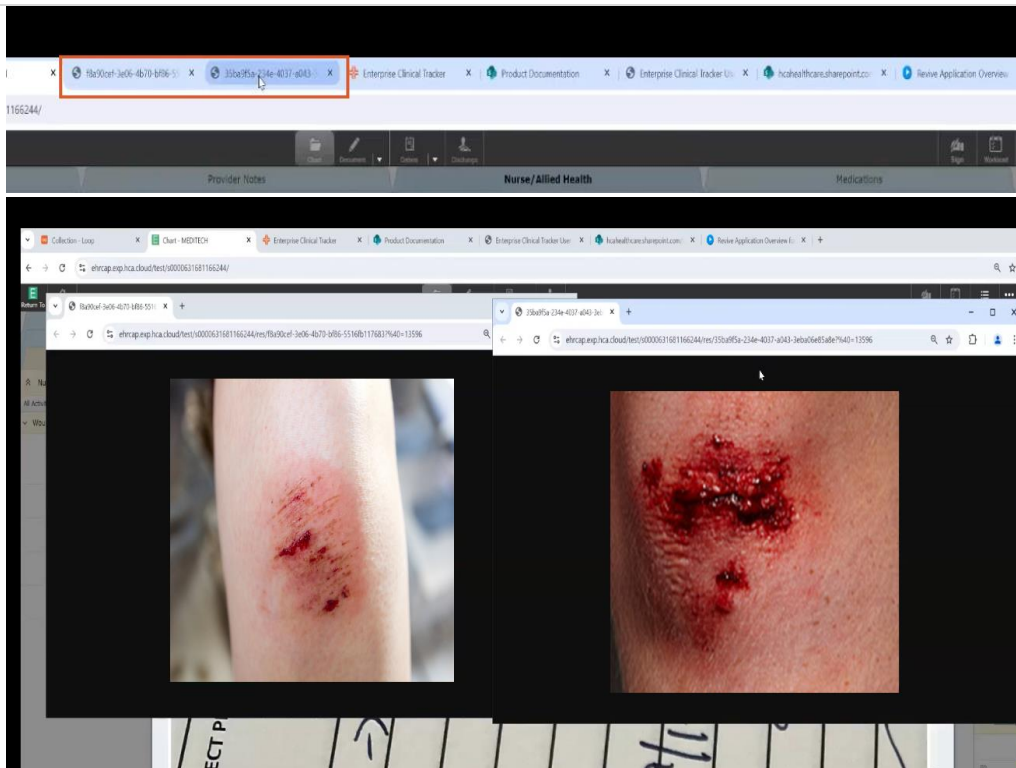


After selecting the Note, it will open in an overlay.

To view "ALL WOUND CARE" or "ALL NOTES" for this patient use the tabs at the top.

For better viewing, right-click on the image to open in a new browser tab.

To view images side by side, pull the newly opened browser windows out by clicking it and dragging.



Use the three dots on the browser bar to access the Zoom button to zoom in on the image. This will affect all open browsers so be sure to readjust after viewing the image.
